- **Students enrolled in English I (9), English II (10), English III (11), and English IV (12) at the college preparatory level** are required to read one novel over the summer. In the first week of school, students will turn in specific assignments, discuss elements within the novel, and be tested over the selection. The grades for these assignments will be part of the first nine weeks average.
- **Students enrolled in Honors English I (9), Honors English II (10), Honors English III (11), and Honors English IV (12)** are required to read two novels over the summer. In the first week of school, students will turn in specific assignments, discuss elements within the novel, and be tested over the selection. The grades for these assignments will be part of the first nine weeks average.
- **Students enrolled in Advanced Placement English Language and Composition (11)** are required to read one novel and one nonfiction selection over the summer. In the first week of school, students will turn in specific assignments, discuss elements within the novel, and be tested over the selection. The grades for these assignments will be part of the first nine weeks average.
- **Students enrolled in Advanced Placement English Literature (12)** are required to read two novels over the summer. In the first week of school, students will turn in specific assignments, discuss elements within the novel, and be tested over the selection. The grades for these assignments will be part of the first nine weeks average.
- **Students enrolled in College Level English (EN 101) (12)** are required to read two novels over the summer. In the first week of school, students will turn in specific assignments, discuss elements within the novel, and be tested over the selection. The grades for these assignments will be part of the semester average.
